## APPLICATION TO RENEW A SMALL GENERAL WATER USE PERMIT FOR AGRICULTURAL USE WITH NO CHANGES

THIS FORM CAN BE COMPLETED BY ALL APPLICANTS TO RENEW EXISTING SMALL GENERAL WATER USE PERMITS FOR AGRICULTURAL USE **WHEN THERE ARE NO CHANGES** TO THE EXISTING WUP, PROVIDED THE EXISTING WUP MEETS THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- **Annual Average Demand** (total gallons in one year divided by 365 days), whether that demand is met solely with ground water, or it is met with a combination of ground water, surface water, and alternative water supply (e.g., reclaimed water, stormwater) meets the following criteria:
  - The total ground water demand is less than 100,000 gallons per day (gpd),
  - The total drought annual average demand is less than 100,000 gpd in the Southern Water Use Caution Area, or
  - The primary withdrawal is from a surface water source and the annual average demand is less than 50,000 gpd.
- **The Maximum Daily Demand** (maximum gallons used in one 24-hour period) quantities are less than 3,000,000 gpd for crop protection or other use.
- In the Dover/Plant City Water Use Caution Area, where there are no frost/freeze protection quantities, and the use does not typically require frost/freeze protection.

**Note: Applicants may apply for a twenty (20) year permit term.**

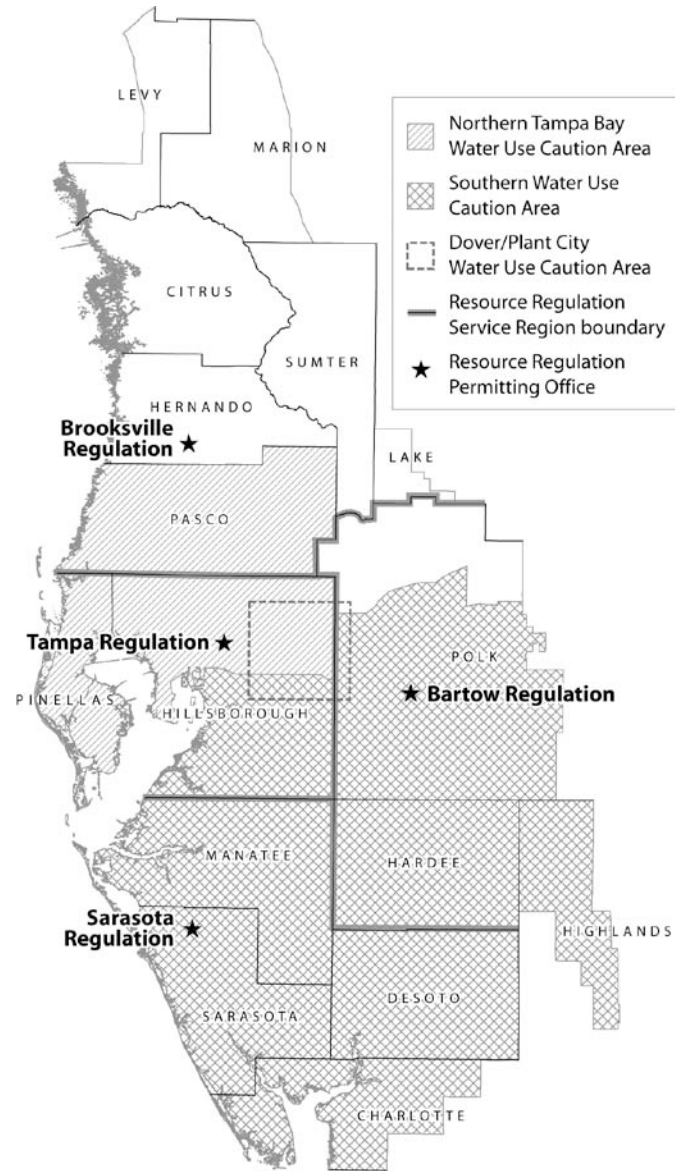
