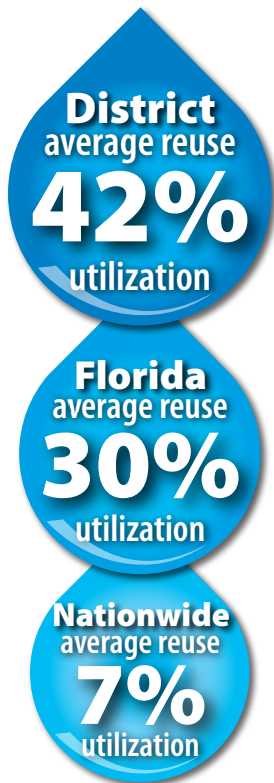

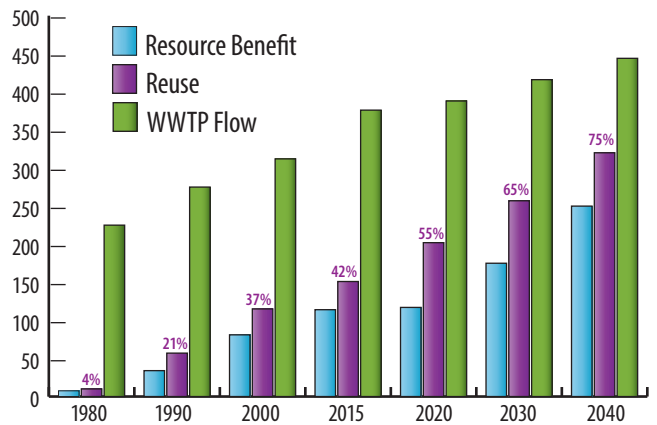


Reuse All-Stars PERCENT UTILIZATION

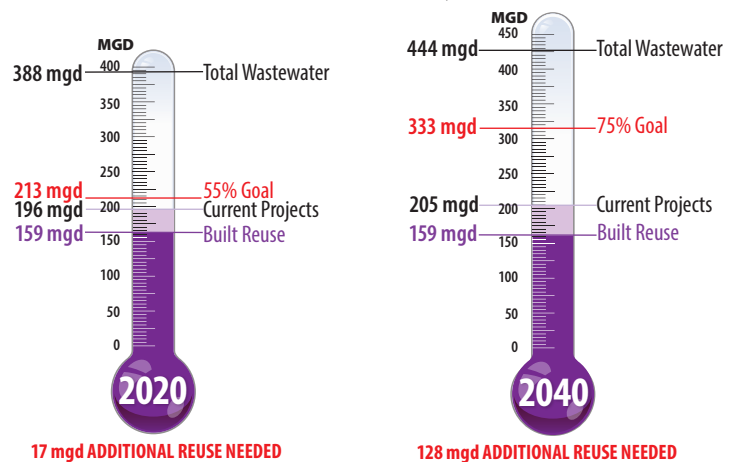
Domestic Wastewater Reused in the District

994 miles of pipeline funded—the distance from Brooksville to Philadelphia



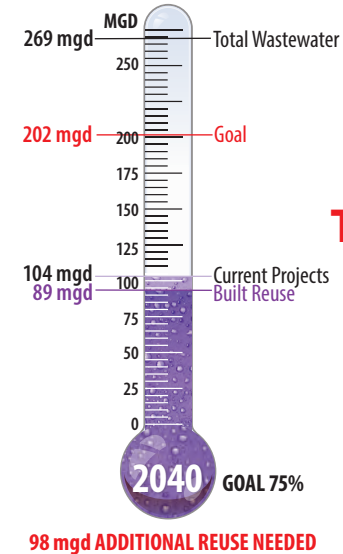
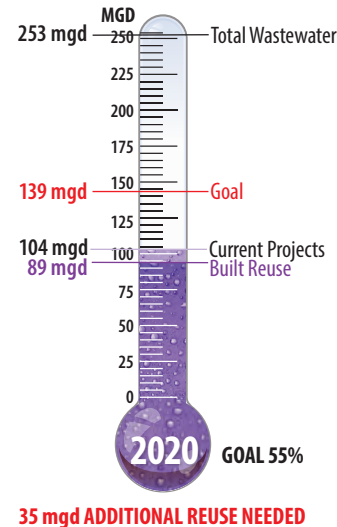
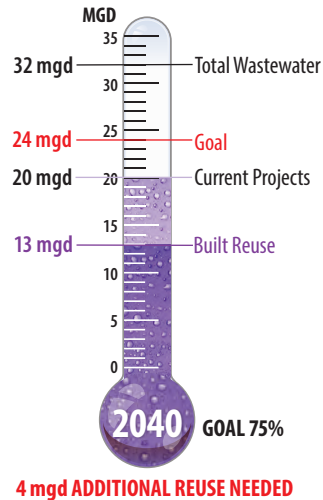
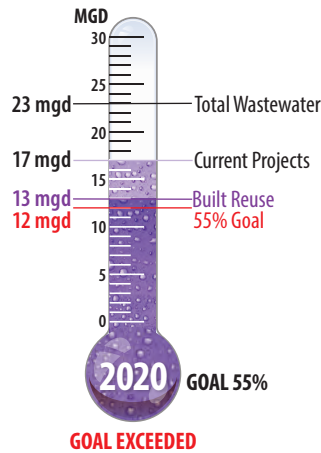

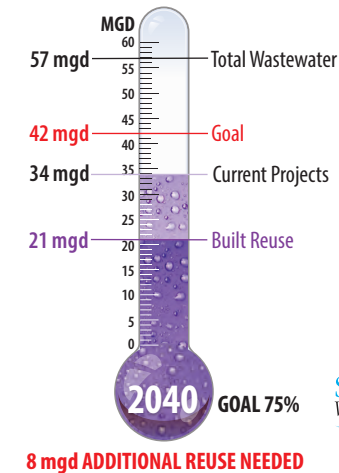
