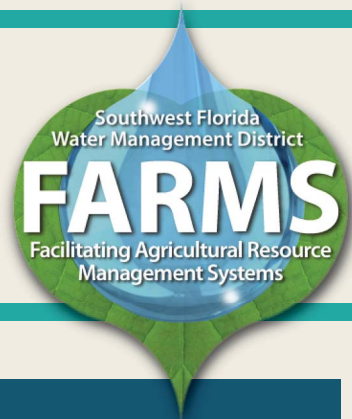


# YOU'RE INVITED ON A FARMS TOUR

Travel to **UF/IFAS Gulf Coast Research and Education Center** located at 14625 CR 672, Wimauma, FL

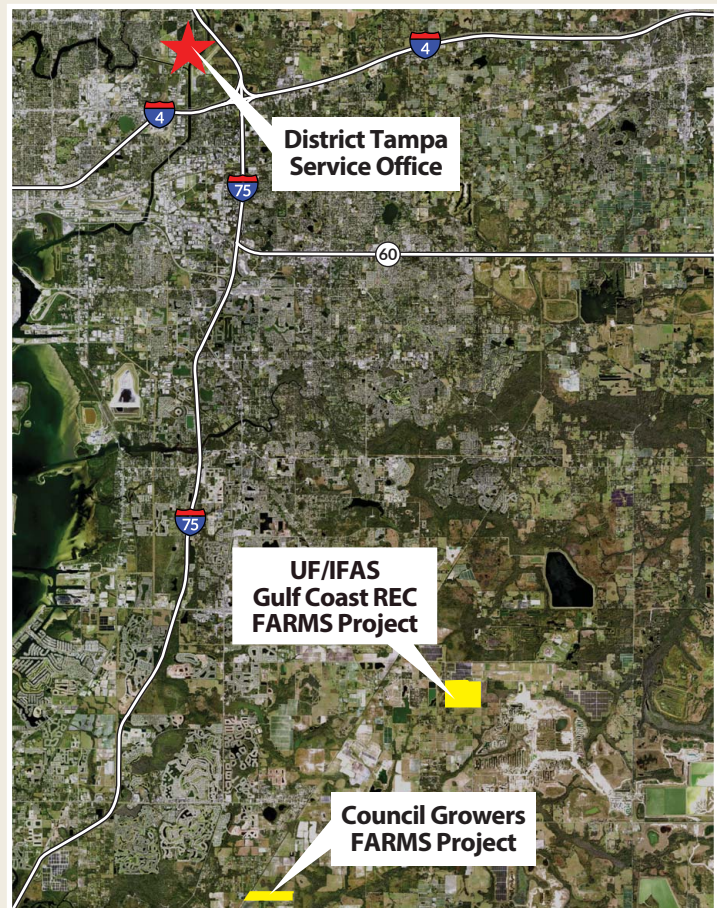
