4. <u>Action Item: FY2022 FDEP Springs Funding and Final Evaluations and Rankings – Vivianna Bendixson, SWFWMD</u>

Ms. Vivianna Bendixson, SWIM Supervisor, provided members with an outline of the FY2022 review process. She supplied the funding summary by Basin Management Action Plan (BMAP) and SWFWMD region and the FY2022 FDEP springs funding requests. Ms. Bendixson discussed the FY2022 Springs funding evaluations sorted by project benefit and cost effectiveness. Ms. Bendixson reviewed the final evaluation changes which included: Hernando County received grant funding allowing the project to be split into two phases and the City of Crystal River withdrew its Wetland Recharge Park application. A total of six projects requested FDEP funding. Future Springs Coast Management and Steering Committee meeting dates were discussed.

A motion was made to approve the final project evaluations and FDEP spreadsheet for projects recommended to be forwarded to FDEP for FY2022 Springs Funding consideration. Staff recommended the Springs Coast Steering Committee (SCSC) forward these projects to the District's Governing Board for approval to send to FDEP for funding consideration. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Ms. Bendixson stated that suggested agenda topics will be discussed at the July 28 SCSC meeting. These topics included recommended changes, future meeting dates and Fiscal Year 2023 funding processes.
