2018 Employee Evaluation for the Executive Director

Background

Board Policy No. 710-2 governs the performance evaluation process for the executive director. The Policy provides that:

- Each Board member shall independently provide input on the executive director's performance in anticipation of Governing Board approval of the annual employee evaluation for each employee.
- With this input, the Governing Board Chair will draft the executive director's 2018 evaluation.
- The executive director shall provide the Board with their proposed goals for 2019, against which they will be reviewed in next year.

Consistent with Board Policy No. 710-2, at this meeting:

- 1. The Board Chair will provide to the Governing Board his draft 2018 evaluation for the District's Executive Director, Brian Armstrong. The Governing Board will have an opportunity to review, discuss and make any changes that it may wish to make to these draft evaluations. The Governing Board will also be asked to approve these evaluations so that they can be finalized and delivered to the employee.
- 2. Executive Director Brian Armstrong will present his proposed 2019 performance goals and objectives. The Governing Board will have the opportunity to review, discuss and make any changes that it may wish to make to the draft goals. The Governing Board will also be asked to approve these items.
