




RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

The Palm River Restoration Project Phase 2 East McKay Bay included the enhancement, restoration, and creation of approximately 53 acres of coastal ecosystem habitats, and water quality improvements prior to discharge into McKay Bay and

ultimately Tampa Bay, a SWIM priority water body. Three ponds were constructed to reduce pollutants in stormwater discharging from a 436-acre urban watershed with an estimated removal of 517 lbs of nitrogen. This project was jointly funded by Tampa Bay Environmental Restoration Fund, FDOT, RESTORE Act funding administered by FDEP, and the District.




Consumptive Use Permitting *Active Staff Processing Time, All Individually-Processed Permits New CUP goal of 27 days in effect October 1, 2020




