District leak detection services have saved 5.93 mgd

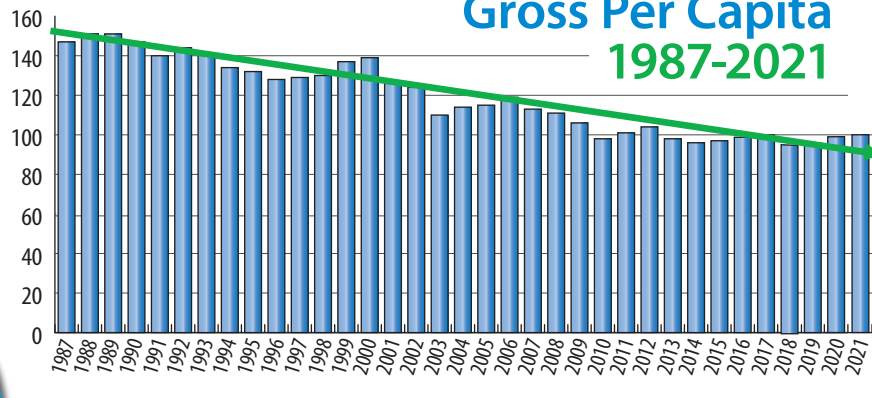


Over 16.8 mgd estimated savings from CFI projects over the past 32 years, including over 291,000 toilet replacements
