## **Miscellaneous Water Uses**

## **Year-Round Water Conservation Measures**

**Car Washing ...** is allowed on any day and at any time, including fund-raising events.

**Fountain Operation ...** may occur on any day and at any time.

**Pressure Washing ...** may occur on any day and at any time.

Water-to-Air Cooling and Heating... includes geothermal units and cooling towers.

- Geothermal units are used in some residential and small commercial buildings; some older models use well water that only passes through the system once.
- Cooling towers are used in schools, libraries and other large buildings; newer models must be carefully operated to provide the appropriate combination of temperature and humidity in a manner that also conserves conserve energy.
- These devices may discharge water on any day and at any time, including the use of an irrigation system or unattended hose, when necessary.

## All Water Uses

- Stricter local ordinances may apply, so also check with your water utility.
- The "wasteful and unnecessary" use of water is still prohibited, including:
  - o Allowing flow from an unattended hose, except cooling/heating/similar device discharges
  - Handwatering a lawn if it is also watered another way, except for spot treatment
  - Hosing-down a driveway or other impervious surface instead of a broom to remove debris
  - o Hosing-down a building instead of using a broom or other dry method to remove debris
  - Allowing water to flow from a broken sprinkler head or other malfunctioning device after being notified by the District or one of its local enforcement partners
