


IMPACTS VISIBLE FROM TIME-LAPSE CAMERAS

Direct impacts to the river system, such as prop scars and uprooting of vegetation or unnatural movement of sand, are being documented in the study. Impacts are visible even from a distance after nearly two weeks of summer use. The first photo was taken July 26 and the second photo August 7.



Activities like docking, wading and trampling also are being documented and their impacts on the natural system, such as the uprooting of vegetation seen above, are being evaluated.
