## **Make Your Own Miniature Wetland**

## **MATERIALS**

- clear plastic soda bottle
- handful of gravel
- small notebook for notes
- handful of sand
- tiny ferns and other wetland plants
- handful of soil
- 12-inch square sheet of clear plastic wrap
- scissors
- water

## **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Ask an adult to cut off the top section of the bottle.
- 2. Fill the bottom with a handful of gravel.
- 3. Place a handful of sand on top of the gravel.
- 4. Place a handful of soil on top of the sand.
- 5. Slope the layers and the surface to make a low spot on one side.
- 6. Evenly space plants on the upper level of the surface.
- 7. Gently pour water to the lowest level until it forms a little pond.
- 8. Place clear plastic wrap over the top of the bottle.
- 9. Place the bottle in a location with filtered sun.
