District leak detection services have saved 5.86 mgd

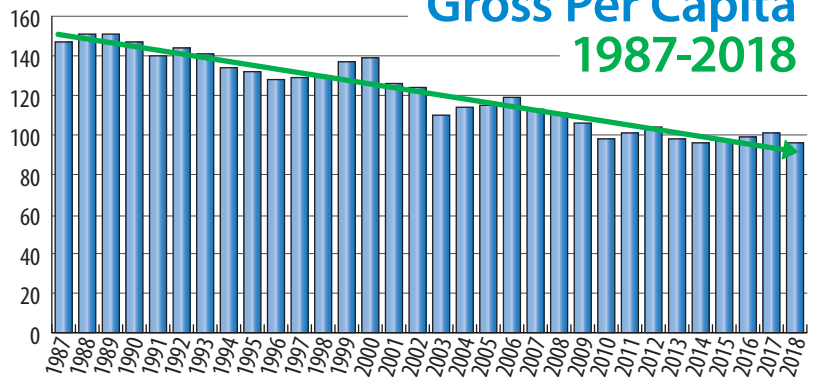


Over 15.6 mgd estimated savings from CFI projects as of FY2020, including over 285,000 toilet replacements
