

**THREE SISTERS SPRINGS
CANAL SHORELINE STABLIZATION
CONSTRUCTION PROJECT
APRIL THROUGH NOVEMBER 2023**

RESTRICTED AREA

**THIS AREA IS A DESIGNATED
CONSTRUCTION SITE AND ANYONE
WHO TRESPASSES ON THIS PROPERTY
COMMITS A FELONY.**

FLORIDA STATUTE 810.09

1. Furnish and erect the “Restricted Area” sign, at the location specified. The sign panel shall be 14 gauge aluminum 18” x 30” flat surface or as required to provide 2” height lettering for “THIS AREA IS A DESIGNATED CONSTRUCTION SITE, AND ANYONE WHO TRESPASSES ON THIS PROPERTY COMMITS A FELONY”. Other wording shall be sized and use fonts as appropriate to provide a sign similar to presentation in Figure 9.
2. The sign shall be mounted on the existing steel posts in the spring run discharge canal near its intersection with the adjacent canal near the park south property boundary as shown in Figure 8. The sign shall be mounted to the existing steel post in two or more locations with appropriate stainless steel hardware to support the sign and protect it from removal by vandalism or efforts to pull the sign from the post. If the sign is removed, it shall be replaced promptly at no additional cost to the District.
3. Complete all fabrication, with the exception of cutting and punching of mounting holes, prior to metal de-greasing. Cut metal panel to size and shape and keep free of buckles, warp, dents, burrs, and defects resulting from fabrication. The sign message shall be prepared and mounted in accordance with the recommendations of the ink or overlay manufacturer to provide a sign that can withstand weathering, chipping, or fading for a minimum period of three years. Provide a finished sign with clear lettering and graphics. Ensure that the finished background panel is essentially a plane surface.
4. Repair and replace the sign containing imperfections or damage regardless of the kind, type, or cause of the imperfections or damage during the project duration. Make repairs according to the manufacturer’s recommendations and to the satisfaction of the District.
