The Southwest Florida Water Management District has scheduled additional Voluntary Site Visits open only to those in attendance at the Mandatory Pre-Response Meeting and Site Visit that were conducted on November 9, 2018. These additional site visits are to allow Respondents more time to conduct additional independent field investigations.

The gate at 6317 State Road 674 will be open from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, November 15, 2018 and Monday, November 19, 2018. The gate will be left unlocked, but Respondents must open the gate and close the gate behind them. The route to the site will be flagged, and Respondents must not deviate off of the marked trail. Once on the project site, Respondents are free to investigate all parts of the site. Access to Gully Branch "C" is by foot only across Gully Branch. Four-wheel drive vehicles or small Utility Vehicles (UTV) are strongly recommended.
