QUESTION: The specifications say that the "The contractor must be

QP1/QP2 Qualified". Does that mean the General Contractor must have that certification or the subcontractor performing the

painting work?

ANSWER: This question will be answered in Set 2 of Questions and Answers to

be provided at a later date.

QUESTION: Does Section 2.13 include Sub-Contractors and who is

responsible for verifying?

ANSWER: Subcontractors are included in the verification process if your

company is paying the subcontractor more than \$3,000.00. The

contractor is responsible for verifying all employees.

QUESTION: Section 2.23 shows N/A. Are there liquidated damages?

ANSWER: No, there are no liquidated damages.

QUESTION: Can we come back to the site before the bid is due.

ANSWER: Yes, the site is open to the public.

QUESTION: QP1 & QP2 includes Seal Coating. Would that apply for

Metallizing?

ANSWER: This question will be answered in Set 2 of Questions and Answers to

QUESTION: Where are the turbidity barriers to be located?

ANSWER: Turbidity barriers will be located around all work areas and staging

areas.

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QUESTION: Where do you envision the erosion area?

ANSWER: There should be no erosion, but all work areas will be surrounded by silt screen

and/or turbidity barriers.

QUESTION: Would the public be closed off from both sections?

ANSWER: Closed signage will be posted at the entrance gates, but the contractor is

responsible for maintaining a closed work zone, posting of signs, and keeping

the public out of the work zone.

QUESTION: Will someone be onsite at all times?

ANSWER: No, not always.

QUESTION: Does it have to be QP1 and QP2?

QUESTION: Will the work be performed outside the hunting season?
