QUESTION: Is there a test account or can we create our own account, in the current ePermitting system so we can get an idea of what the current system looks like and what challenges the current system may be posing to your organization?

ANSWER: Yes, there is a test system that you may access. You may create accounts for the Water Use Permit, Environmental Resource Permit, and Well Construction Permit Application to view the current ePermitting system (from the permit applicant's perspective) by visiting the following District test system locations:

QUESTION: Is there an estimate of how much on-site travel will be required?

ANSWER: For the initial development cycle, it is expected that the consultant will conduct on-site travel for the first month; then, one week per month thereafter. It is anticipated that future development cycles will average one week per month on-site travel and the remainder of work remotely.
